**St Fagans National Museum of History & The Royal Mint, Llantrisant, Cardiff**  
**Excursion on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2018**

**St. Fagans National Museum of History** stands in the grounds of the magnificent St Fagans Castle and gardens, a late 16th-century manor house donated by the Earl of Plymouth in 1948. Since then, over forty original buildings from different periods of Welsh history have been re-erected in the 100-acre parkland, among them houses, a farm, a school, a chapel and a splendid Workmen's Institute. St Fagans explores all aspects of how people in Wales have lived, worked and spent their leisure time.

**The Royal Mint**, based in South Wales since 1968, is the only place in the world where you can watch the UK's coins being made. We will go behind the scenes to follow the journey of a coin from a blank to a bank in the 45 minute guided Factory Experience. There will also be time for a self-guided visit to the diverse exhibition areas.

**Cost** £27.50 per person, including coach, entrance and guided tour for The Royal Mint, and gratuities. Refreshments, e.g. morning coffee, lunch and afternoon tea, will be self-funded. **Refund policy on final page.**

**The Programme** - all timings are approximate

**10.30 am:** arrival at our first destination, **St Fagans National Museum of History**. Members have the rest of the morning to explore the Museum, with its 50 or more buildings scattered over a very wide area. In view of the size of the site, members will need to be selective over how many buildings they choose to visit and their choice of route. Maps will be supplied. Admission to St Fagans is free.

**Lunch:** buy lunch in the 3 cafes (one is in the new Entrance / Visitor Centre) or picnic. The Gwalia Tea Rooms involve steep stairs.

**1.45 pm: the coach will leave St. Fagans promptly.**

**2.15 pm:** arrive at the **Royal Mint, Llantrisant**. We will be divided into two groups for successive guided tours of the Factory Experience starting at 2.30 pm and 2.45 pm. There will be time for a good look at the exhibition and to have a self-funded tea in the Café.

**5.00 pm: the coach leaves promptly for the return journey**

**What to wear:** rainwear in case of inclement weather and good walking shoes or boots as there is plenty of walking at St Fagans.

**Access:** both venues have wheelchairs on request, free of charge, on a first come first served basis. Royal Mint entrance for a wheelchair companion is free. The coach has storage for wheelchairs/scooters

**St Fagans:** the terrain on the Castle side of the Museum is steep in places. Due to the historic nature of a few buildings, access may be difficult. Moveable ramps & a lift are available at the Oakdale Workmen's Institute. A motorised Disabled Tour Vehicle (DTV) is available to transport visitors – up to 5 including companions - to parts of the site but must be **pre-booked well in advance**.

**Royal Mint:** level access, all under cover.
